TCOLE Reporting

Be sure to provide your full and correct name and your Texas PID number through the training site before printing the course completion certificate. 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Generally, Wednesday thru Wednesday course completions are submitted to TCOLE on Friday of each week. Additionally, we will send you a confirmation email when we do submit your course to TCOLE for posting. Please note, course reporting is not a complete automated process ... there is a representative at TCOLE who reviews and actually posts the course credit to your records. Course hours are generally posted sooner ... however, typically, no later than Monday.
